INDICATE INTEREST

To indicate your interest in integrating API v3.0, please email our <u>integrations team.</u> A member of our team will reach out to you to identify which banking services you would like integrated with API v3.0 and to enroll you in Silvergate Portal for service management and permissioning.

PORTAL REGISTRATION AND SUBSCRIPTION ACTIVATION

We will create a Silvergate Portal profile to manage your API subscription, services and limits. Once your profile is created, your administrator will receive the following emails:

- Silvergate Portal profile administrator activation email:
 This invitation will activate your administrator's user profile.
 Once activated, the administrator can complete your API subscription setup including permissions and secret generation.
- 2. New API subscription email:

This email confirms a new subscription has been created and includes a link to our new online documentation including endpoints and content requirements.

Following subscription setup, use the tools and information to begin coding.

CODE IN SANDBOX

Use the new online documentation to begin coding to API v3.0 in the Sandbox. Upon several successful calls to the new endpoints, you will follow a similar process to code to our production environment.

Once you've coded to the API v3.0, you will move to production and complete any remaining agreements.
